

Hayfield Pathway Endowed Scholarship

In October of 1999, an engraved brick walkway replaced the concrete sidewalk in front of the historic Hayfield House on the campus of Penn State Wilkes-Barre. This opened a whole new source of scholarship funds to aid deserving students. The funds generated from the



Hayfield Pathway Endowed Scholarship will help Penn State Wilkes-Barre students achieve their academic goals. Approximately 75% of our students receive financial aid through grants, scholarships, work study programs, and loans. In addition to a demonstrated financial need, students who are awarded campus scholarships have proven themselves academically strong and exhibit a desire to learn and excel.

Alumni, faculty, staff, and community members have purchased bricks for themselves or as lasting tributes to Penn State graduates, friends, or relatives. Bricks are available in three sizes:

- \$125 4"x 8" (up to 3 lines of engraving with up to 13 characters per line)
- \$300 8"x 8" (up to 3 lines of engraving with up to 13 characters per line)
- \$5000 20"x 24" (up to 4 lines of engraving with up to 14 characters per line)

A limited number of bricks are available, so order your brick(s) today and help pave the way for a Penn State education!

Contributions are tax deductible. Penn State Wilkes-Barre reserves the right in its discretion to deny any application to purchase a brick. Purchaser shall have no control over the location of the brick in the walkway or its date of installation. Even though the bricks are designed for hard use and longevity, Penn State Wilkes-Barre cannot be responsible for guaranteeing the lifespan of the bricks. Purchaser agrees that the brick may be permanently removed at the discretion of Penn State Wilkes-Barre without any compensation, refund, or recourse owed to the purchaser. Purchaser will have no control over the design, format, material, repair, or access to the brick in the walkway. Purchaser recognizes that the brick may chip, crack, wear or otherwise become damaged due to any cause.
